5 When you've solved all of the clues, use the top word and the bottom word to fill in the mystery sentence at the bottom of the ladder.

4 Keep moving up the ladder until you reach the top!

3 Move up to the next ladder rung. Use the next clue to make a new word.

2 Use the clues to change the first word into a new word that fits in the blanks.

1 Start at the bottom. Look at the first word and read the first clue.

3. What you wear between your foot and your shoe.
Change 2 letters.

1. To have traded something for money.
Take away 1 letter.
Start Here

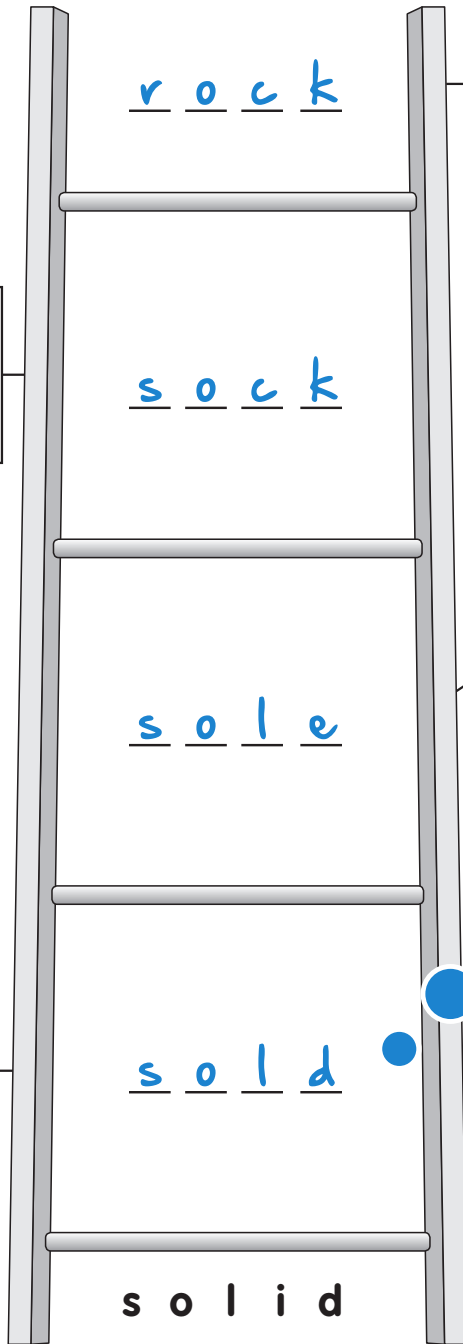
4. Solid matter full of minerals found on the earth's surface.
Change 1 letter.

2. The very bottom of your foot.
Change 1 letter.

I think it means to have sold something....If I take one letter, *i*, away from *solid*, I get *sold*. It works!

TIP!
Each clue gives you hints about

- the new word's meaning.
- how to change the letters in the last word to make a new one.



Idiom: solid as a rock.
Meaning: unshakable; a sure thing
