

Kid Tips for Buddy Reading With Younger Kids

How Do I Keep Their Attention?

- **Keep young kids entertained** by reading with a lot of expression.
- **Make sound effects throughout the book** to match what you are reading. If there is a train, make a “toot toot” sound. Or, if there is a monster, make a monster sound.
- **Tell kids they can ask questions** during the reading. Then stop and answer questions when they have them.
- **Read slowly** so they catch all the words.
- **Stop and ask them questions** about the book as you go, such as, “Where is the brown dog?” and “Why is the dog sad?” Or have them point to things on the page and talk about them.
- **At the end, ask kids for their favorite part.** Then have them find it in the book and tell why it was their favorite.

Teacher Tips for Buddy Reading With Younger Kids

How Do I Organize and Manage Buddy Reading?

- **Put kids in groups of four** instead of two, so if someone is absent, everyone still has a partner or group.
- **Show older students how to act and read** with younger children. Use the “Kid Tips for Buddy Reading With Younger Kids” to help.
- **Have the older children practice reading the book several times** before they read to the younger kids. They should sound fluent in their reading to keep the younger students’ attention.
- **Let kids get to know each other** at the beginning. Have an activity planned that will help them with this.
- **Allow kids to sit where they want.** The younger ones can even bring a pillow and find a cozy spot to read in the classroom with their buddy/buddies.

How to Read a Poem

- Look at the poem's title. What might this poem be about?
- Read the poem aloud without trying to understand it.
- Read it again for understanding. Start with what you know. Underline the parts you do not understand.
- Clarify the meaning of unfamiliar words.
- Look for patterns. Watch for repeated, interesting, or unfamiliar use of language, imagery, sound, color, or arrangement. What might the poet be trying to do with these patterns?
- Look for changes within the poem—in tone, focus, narrator, structure, voice, or patterns. What has changed and what does the change mean?
- Who is speaking in the poem? What does the poem tell you about the speaker?
- Know what the poem means so you know where to use expression.



Poetry Reading Strategies

Preview the poem by reading the title and paying attention to the poem's form (shape on the page, stanzas, number of lines, and ending punctuation).

Read the poem aloud several times to hear rhyme, rhythm, and the overall sound of the poem. This makes it easier to understand the poem.

Visualize the images by paying close attention to strong verbs and comparisons in the poem. Do the images remind you of anything? Let the comparisons paint a picture in your head.

Clarify words and phrases by allowing yourself to find the meanings of words or phrases that stand out, or are repeated. If you do not understand a meaning, use a dictionary, use context clues, or ask a teacher or peer.

Evaluate the poem's theme by asking what message the poet is trying to send. Does it relate to your life in any way?
