Five Proven Ways to Use First Book Resources

Tips from First Book members on how they use the books and resources:

- 1. Spread the joy of reading. Add bookshelves stocked with free books to community centers, parks, playgrounds, laundromats, barbershops, and anywhere else children can find them.
- 2. Reward good behavior or attendance in your classroom or program with books and games that the students can take home and keep.
- **3.** Keep a closet at your school or program stocked with basic-needs items that children can use when they need them.
- **4.** Build or refresh your classroom library with diverse titles so that children can see themselves in the stories they read, and learn about other backgrounds and cultures.
- 5. Incentivize family participation at Back to School Night and other events by giving families a book to add to their home library. This helps encourage a culture of reading at home and extends the message that reading is for everyone.
