Tool #3: Two Letters of Introduction

This tool is a way to help you reach out and connect with families on the first day of school. Ilene created this letter to introduce herself to families, share her contact information, and make clear her school's strong belief that children do their best when families and teachers are partners. While Ilene's example letter is directed toward the parents of students in second grade, Jessica has written similar letters to the families of her high school students, and includes one on the next page.

Dear Second-Grade Families,

We are delighted to be teaching your child in second grade this school year, and we are eager to get to know you as well. We believe that each child does his or her best when families and teachers work closely together.

In Gallaudet, the lead teacher is Emma Fialka-Feldman. She will be assisted by Boston Teacher Resident Maya Taft-Morales, and by Dudley Promise Corps member Tracy Curtin. In George Mason, the lead teacher is Ilene Carver. She will be assisted by Boston Teacher Resident, Nanna Waldroup and by Dudley Promise Corps member Xavier Villalona.

We have spoken with many families already, but in case we have not reached you, we want you to be sure to have our phone numbers. Ms. Carver can be reached at 555-555-5555 and Ms. F. can be reached at 555-555-5555. We are reaching out by phone to every second-grade family so that you can share with us whatever information you think we should know to help us be the best teacher of your child this year. Please expect to hear from us regularly and feel free to contact us with your questions, concerns, and any "good news" you want to share. We ask that you not call us between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on school days, except for an emergency. Those are the hours we are with the children and it is extremely hard for us to shift our focus.

Starting today, our children are reading, writing, engaging in math, and talking together about how to build a second-grade community where each child learns a lot and enjoys his or her school experience. The "specials" we have in second grade are Science, Art, Physical Education, and "Playmakers," an activity-based period focused on joyful community-building. We will send out a schedule soon.
