Long <i>i</i>	pine	<i>i_e</i> <i>i, ie, igh, ei, eigh, uy, y</i>
Short <i>o</i>	pot	<i>o</i>
Long <i>o</i>	so	<i>o</i> <i>o_e, oa, oe, ou, ew, ow, ough, eau</i>
Short <i>u</i>	pun	<i>u</i> <i>ou</i>
