Grades 6–8

Lesson Plan: Let's Explore INK!

Featured Teaching Artist: Linette Ballantyne, Toronto, Ontario

Identity: Students will explore how ink is made and create their own ink that represents who they are. They will look at themselves as future inventors and scientists.

Skills: Students will use a variety of forms (oral, written, graphic, multimedia) to communicate with different audiences and for a variety of purposes. They will investigate the properties of fluids and demonstrate an understanding of their properties and uses.

Intellect: Students will learn the history of the paper and ink created by Egyptians.

Criticality: Students will explore the obstacles that people face when they are not able to communicate using a pen or pencil. Students will explore the barriers and bias that may prevent someone from reaching their goals. What needs to be created so that everyone can reach their goals?

Joy: Students will write their name in the ink they created along with a word that is meaningful to them. They will include a quotation/song that represents who they are.
