- Are you interested in reading more about this topic if we can find books with _____ (fewer words on the page, more illustrations, etc.)?

NAVIGATION

• **Do you like to read books like this that** _____ (you can dip into and out of in any order, you read from start to finish, you choose the path the story takes, etc.)?
