
- **1.** Players take turns rolling all three cubes and reading the letters that land face up. The player then tries to use the letters to form words.
 - If one or more words can be formed, the player records the word(s) on a sheet of paper.
 - If not, the next player takes a turn.
- **2.** Players continue taking turns. (Different players may form the same words.) The first player to form five different words wins the game.

To the teacher: Copy and cut out the student directions above. Glue directions to the front of a ziplock bag. Copy the three letter cube patterns (pages 168–169) on card stock, cut them out, and assemble as shown below. Then place the cubes inside the bag. (A blank template is provided on page 169 for you to create your own letter cubes.)

To assemble each cube, cut and fold, as shown. Glue or tape closed.


