What's Your Problem?

Use this chart to find out why two animals need advice. Circle the animal, then write advice that Dr. Glider might give the dog OR the cat.

Cat	Cat's problem: You just don't feel like cleaning yourself because your mouth is dry. Why is this a problem? Grooming is a cooling device for cats using saliva. So if there's no grooming? You have a kitty who can't cool off.
Dog	Dog's problem: I have a really dry nose. Why is this a problem? Dogs' noses should be wet. The thin layer of mucus helps improve their sense of smell and keep their noses working.
