

Note-Taking Guidelines

Tickling a Trout



1. Think about the life lessons Joseph learned when his grandfather taught him how to tickle a trout. Jot down the ideas you have in your notebook.
2. Skim “Tickling a Trout” to find one important life lesson that Joseph learned from his grandfather and then clearly show how Joseph used this lesson later in his life. You may find details that support your one of your ideas from Step 1, and you may choose an additional lesson.
3. Record in your notebook the specific evidence that shows the lesson(s) Joseph learned, using your own words. Your evidence may be a fact or an inference based on a specific detail.
