- 1. Select five or more terms from the Literary Elements handout that you want students to define and give specific examples of.
- 2. Determine how you will give the assignment: write the elements on the board or use the form below.
- 3. Have students take out a sheet of paper or hand out a test form; have students write their name on it.
- 4. On the chalkboard write the literary terms and explain that students should do two things for each one:
 - Define the term in a complete sentence.
 - Demonstrate understanding of the term by providing examples from the short story they read.
- 5. Give students enough time to write their definitions and examples. Collect the tests and grade assigning fewer points to the definition and more points to the connections students make to a text.
