
I Know My ABC's

Directions:


- 1. Players place the picture cards facedown.
- 2. The first player takes a card and states the picture name. The player then finds the letter on the game board that matches the first letter in the picture name. He or she covers the letter with the card.
- 3. Players keep taking turns until all of the picture cards have been placed. The teacher or another adult checks for accuracy and provides corrective feedback.
- 4. Challenge children to name other words that begin with each letter-sound.




I Know My ABC's Game Board


