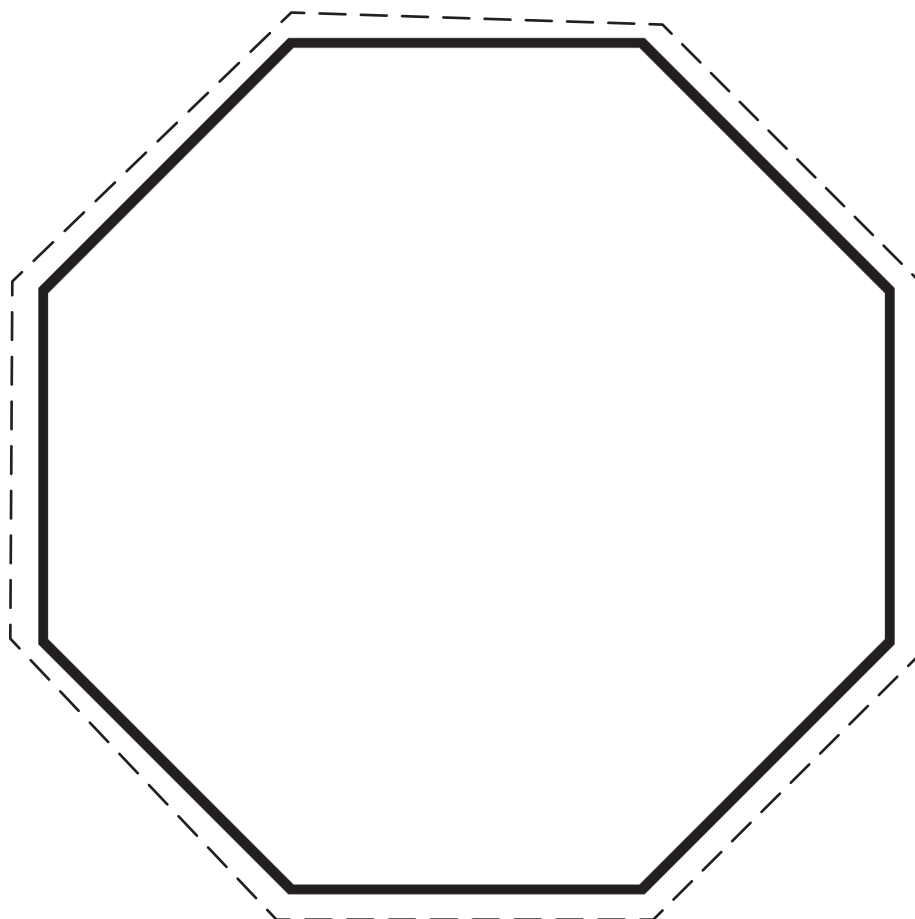
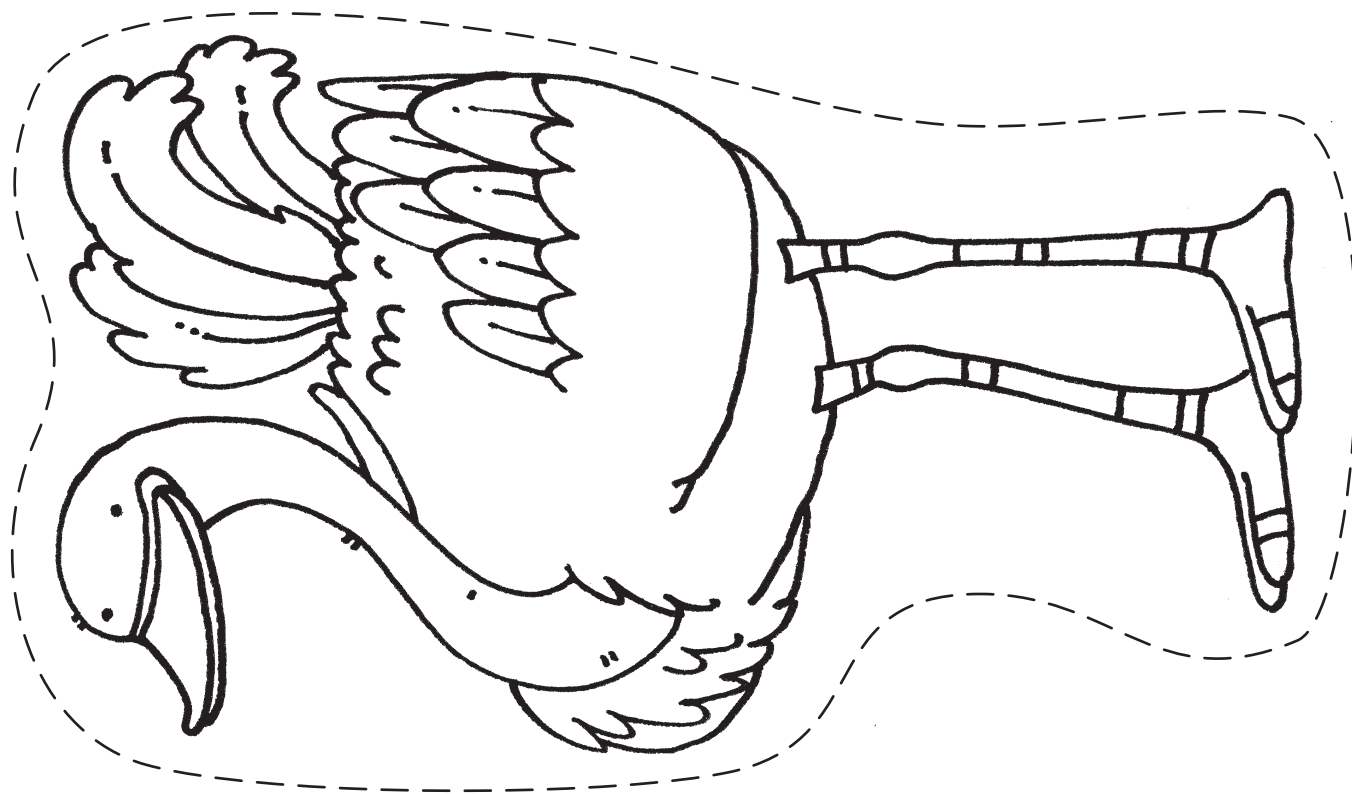


Picture Patterns

To the Teacher: Copy and cut out the octagon and ostrich patterns. Use the pictures for instructional activities, center games, and bulletin boards.

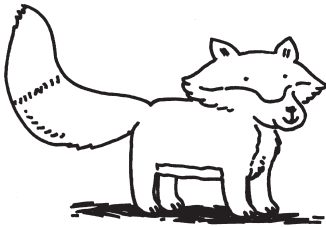

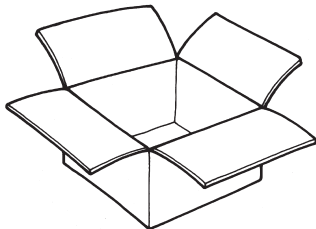
Lace-Up Cards

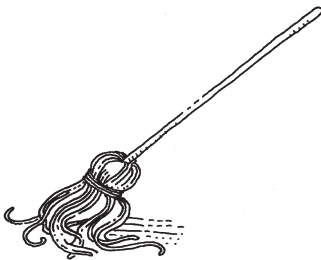
Have children thread the yarn through the holes to match each picture to its corresponding picture name.

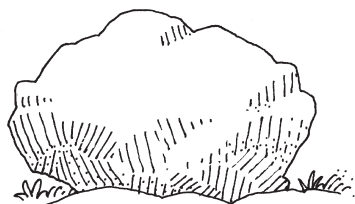

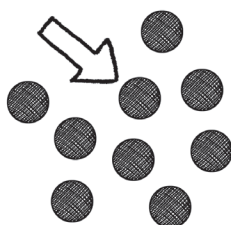
