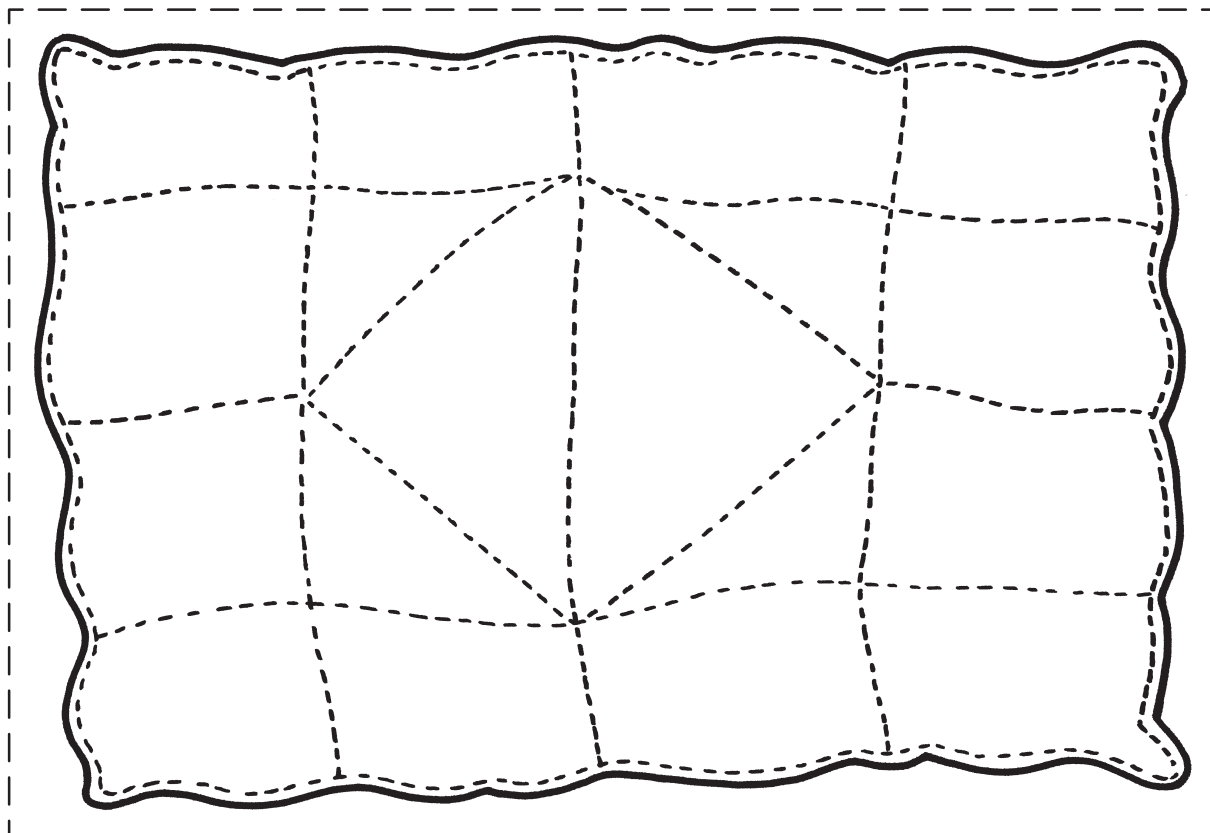
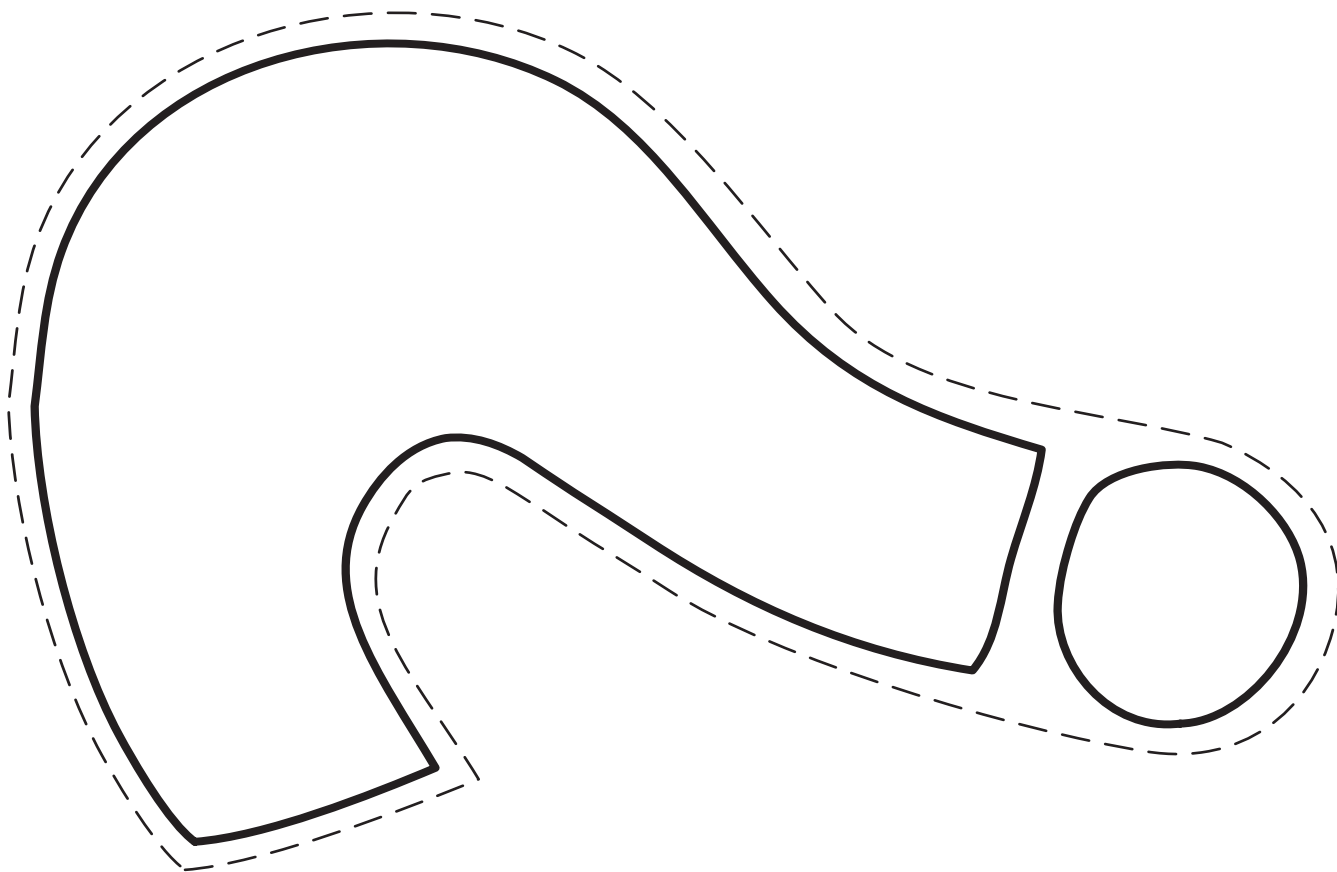


Picture Patterns

To the Teacher: Copy and cut out the question mark and quilt patterns. Use the pictures for instructional activities, center games, and bulletin boards.

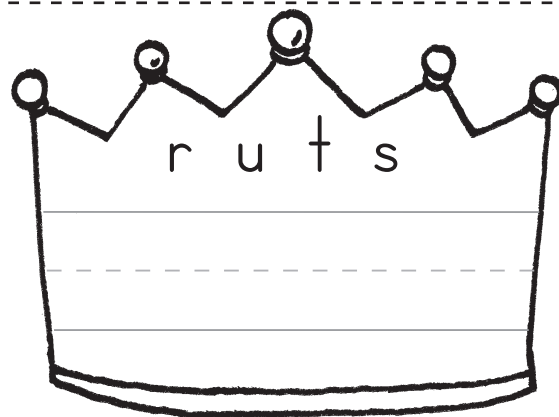
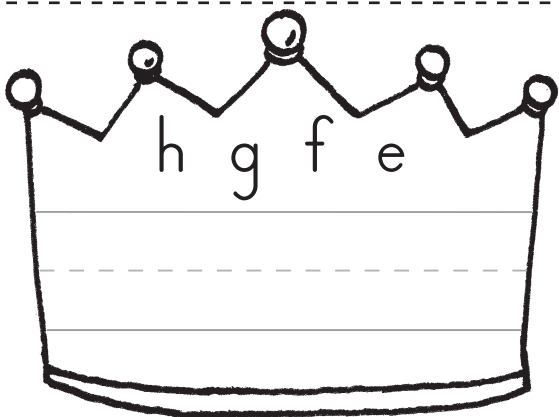
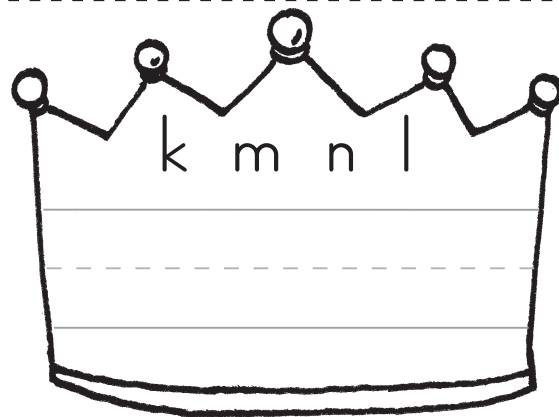
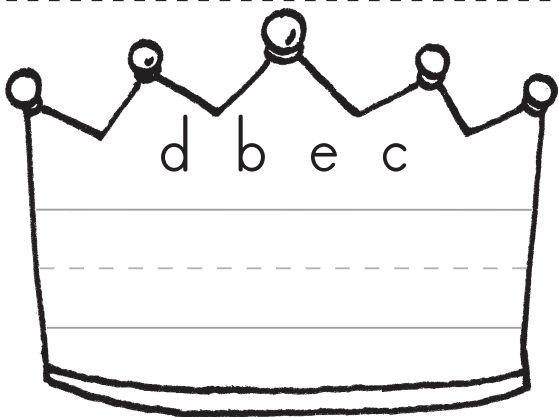
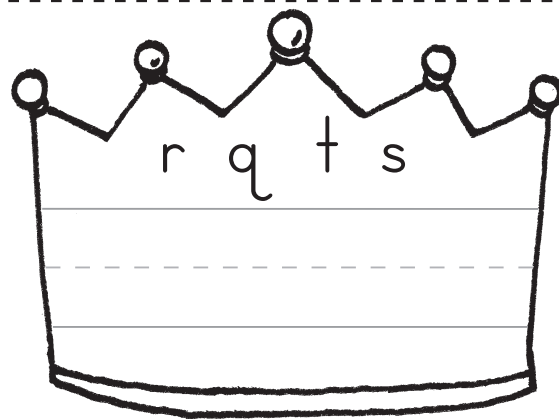
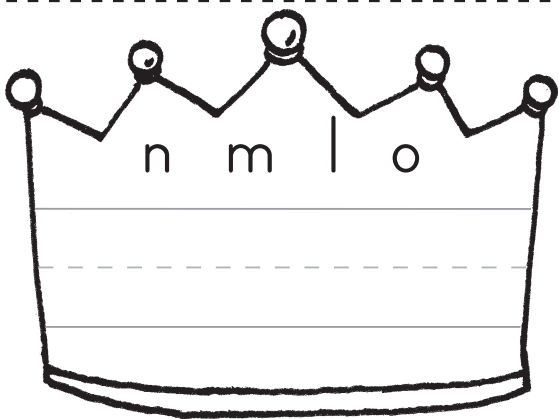

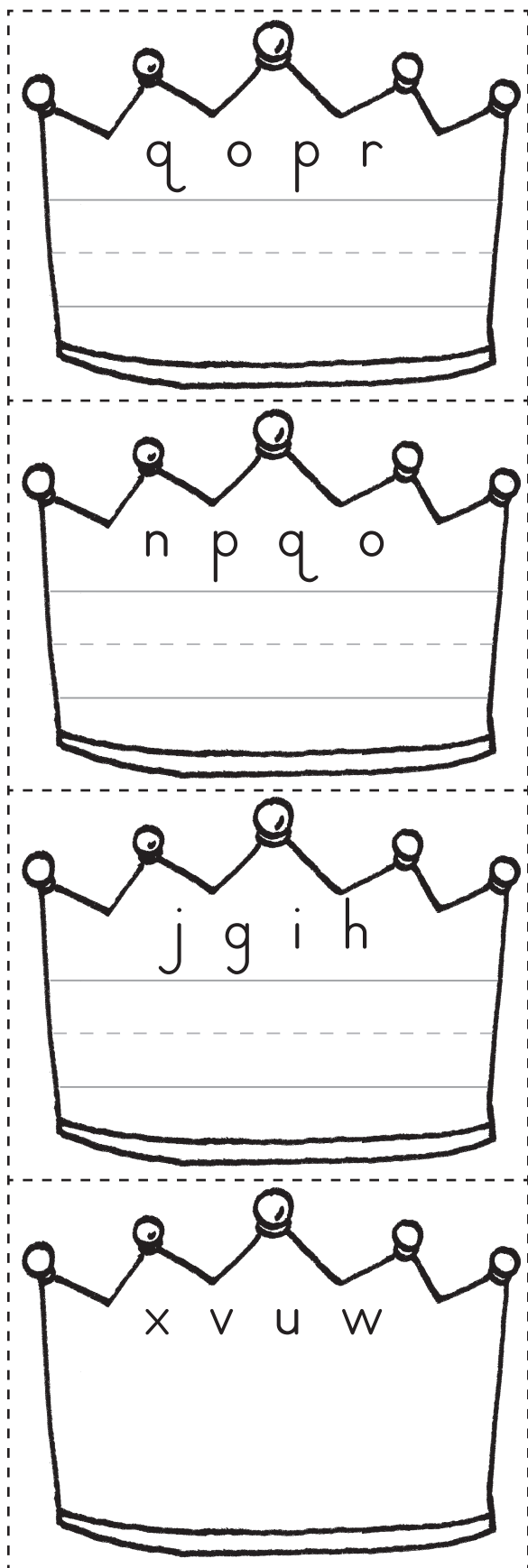
Put the Crowns in Order

Directions:

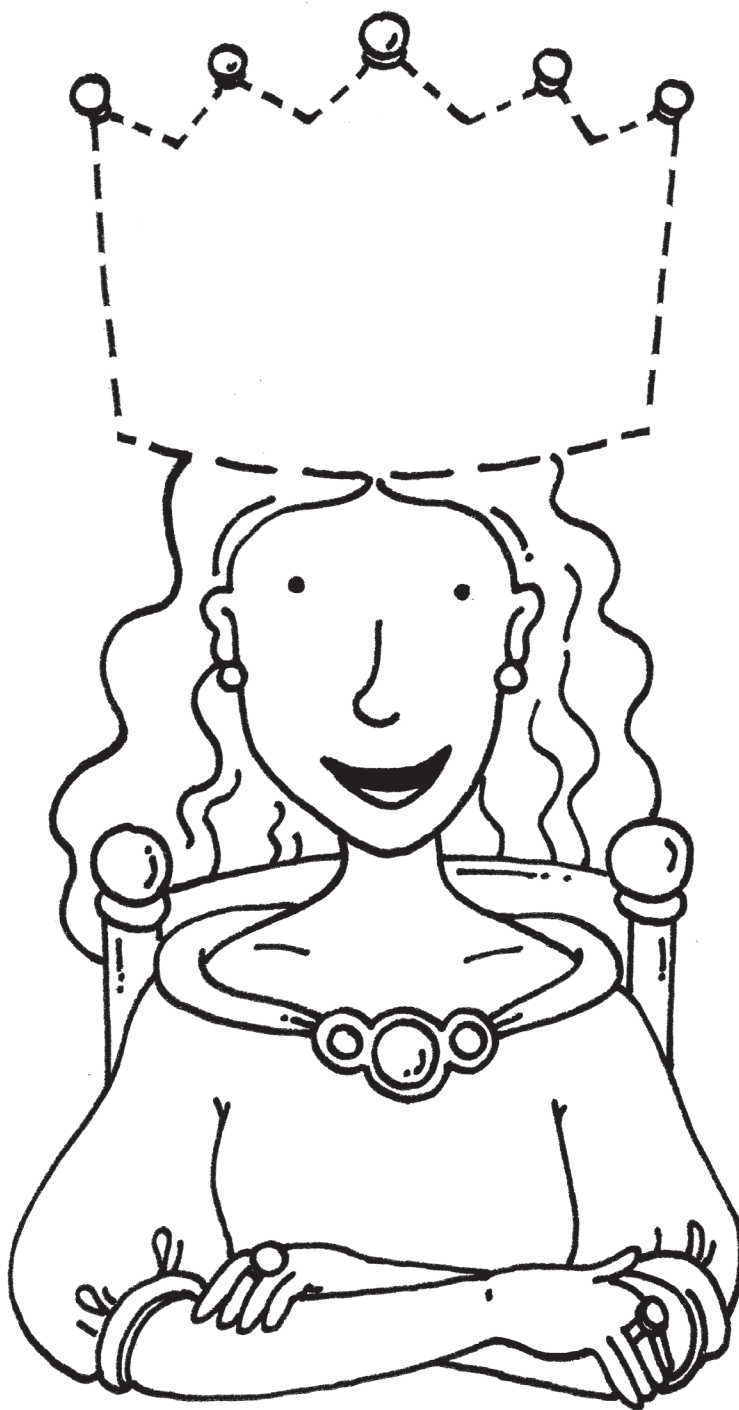
1. Tell children that the letters on each crown are in jumbled order. However, the queen likes order. Their job is to put the letters on each crown in ABC order.
