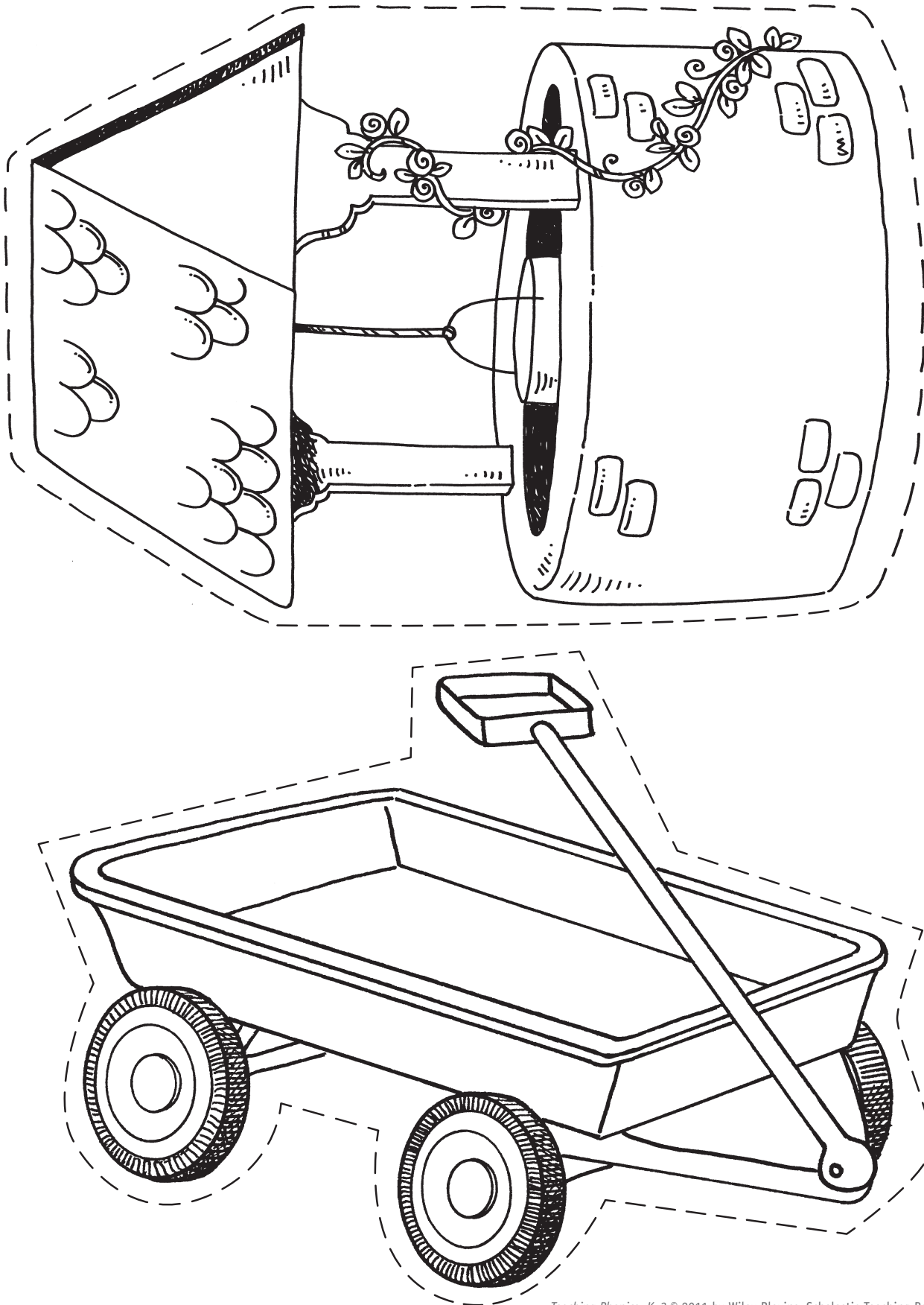


Picture Patterns

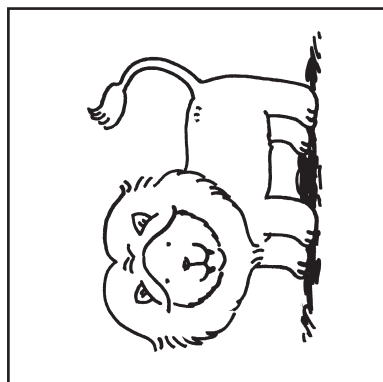
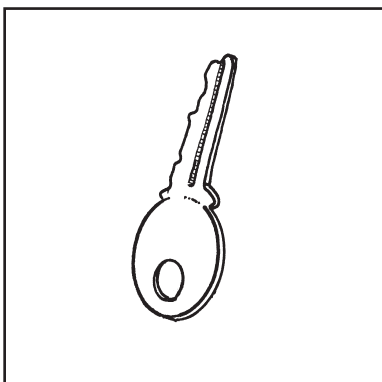
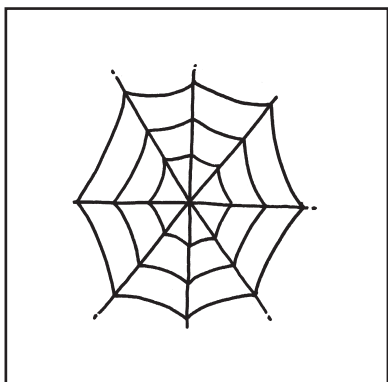
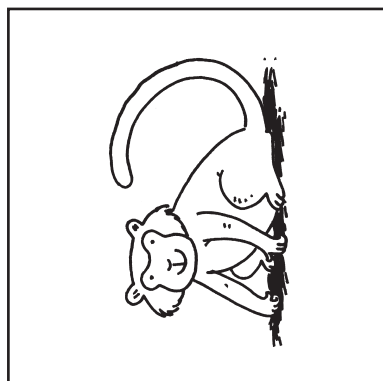
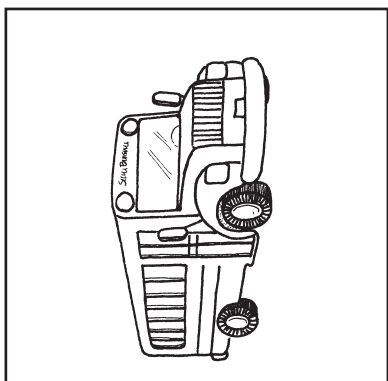
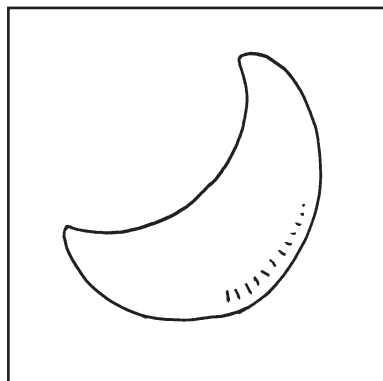
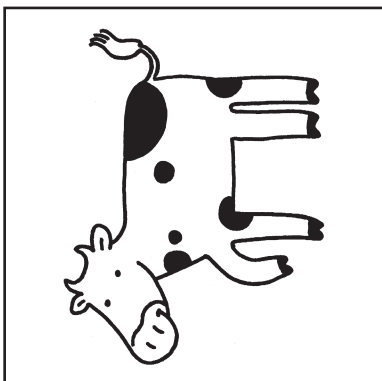
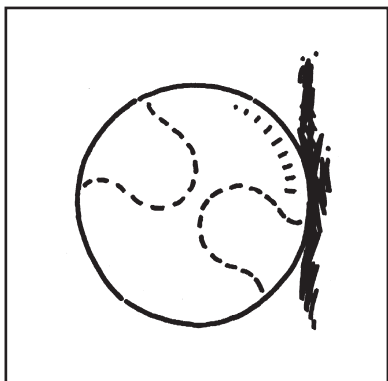
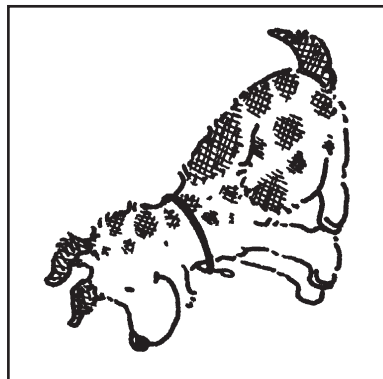
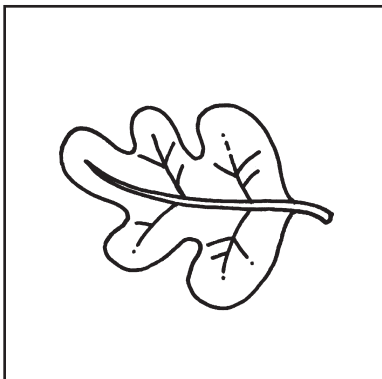
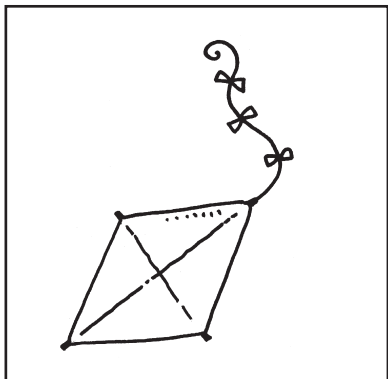
Children can play Sound Dominoes independently, with a partner, or in a small group.

1. Players begin by placing the domino cards facedown.
2. Players take turns choosing a card and connecting one of its pictures end to end or side to side with a domino that has a picture whose name has the same beginning sound.
3. When players make connections, have them say the picture names aloud to check that they have the same beginning sound.
4. Players keep taking turns until all of the cards have been connected.

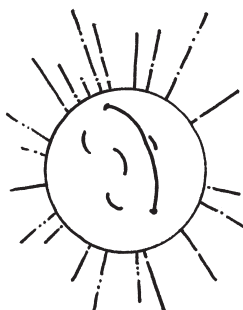
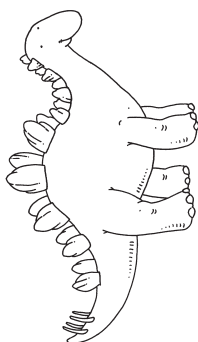
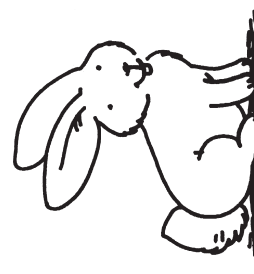
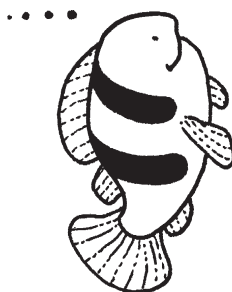
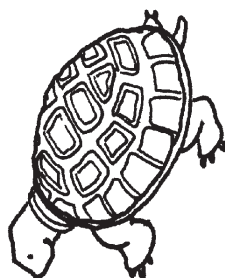
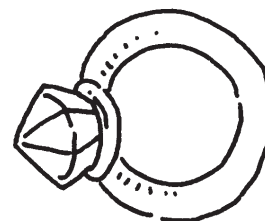
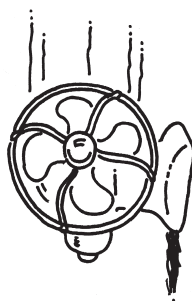
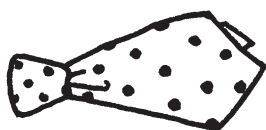
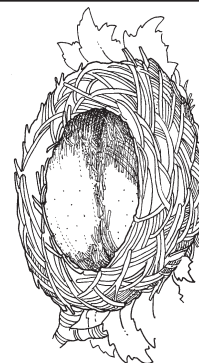
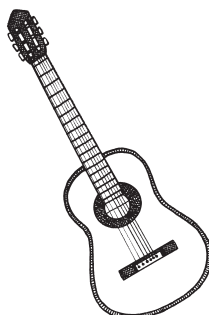
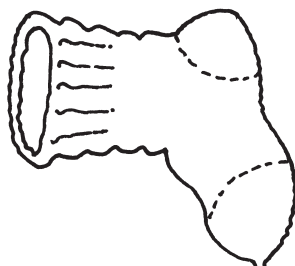
