How Guided Reading Supports Students' Reading

In Guided Reading, the teacher is a critical part of helping students read increasingly challenging texts with understanding and fluency.



Working with students in Guided Reading groups, teachers constantly balance the difficulty of the text with support for students reading the text.

Teachers introduce the story to the group, support individuals through brief interactions while they read, and guide them in talking together afterward about the words and ideas in the text. In this way, teachers help individual readers move forward in developing a reading process.

When students read a variety of books, they're exposed to different writing styles, subject matter, and types of texts. They shift from interpreting individual words to gaining a stronger understanding of language and its meaning.

Guided Reading and Small-Group Instruction

Educators first began organizing students into small groups by reading ability in the late 1800s. Since then, several changes have been made to these traditional reading groups to better support students of different reading levels. Guided Reading is designed with characteristics that allow teachers to more effectively teach reading strategies, assess student progress, and differentiate instruction for each student. As a result each student has the opportunity to read increasingly challenging books and improve his or her reading comprehension.



GRUFFALO PLAY

Summary & Standard

In this play, a mouse outwits forest predators and then encounters the creature he "invented."

Genre/Text Type

Fantasy/Play Remind children that a fantasy is a story that could not happen in the real world. The script of a play tells how to perform that story.

Text Features

Stage Directions Tell children that stage directions are written instructions in a play that tell the actors what to do. Point out examples on page 8: Exit Fox and Enter Owl.

Vocabulary

Domain-Specific Vocabulary

script (p. 4) text of a play narrator (p. 5) storyteller

Academic Vocabulary stroll (p. 7) a relaxed walk

terribly (p. 7) very or extremely

wart (p. 10) a small, hard lump on the skin

Challenging Features

Text Children may be challenged by the play format. Vocabulary Children may find some of the vocabulary challenging, such as opposite in the stage directions on page 7 and crumble on page 24. Use pantomime to support understanding of these words.

Supportive Features

Text The rhythm and rhyme in the play make it fun to read. The text is large and clear.

Content Children will enjoy seeing a beloved character in a new genre. The illustrations support understanding of the plot.

A First Look

Have children look at the cover and read the title. Ask: Which character do you think is the Gruffalo? Why? Have children examine the cover illustration to identify other possible characters. Ask: What feature in the illustration gives you a hint that you are about to read a play?

GUIDED READING

Read and Analyze Literature

Understand Text Type

Remind children that a play tells a story using dialogue spoken by actors who play the characters. The words that the characters speak are marked by their names or, in this case, illustrations of them. Explain that stage directions are not spoken aloud. They tell the actors what to do.

(pp. 5–6) Who are the characters in this play? What does the illustration tell you about the play's setting, or where it takes place?

(p. 7) What do you notice about each character's dialogue?

(pp. 7–11) How is the conversation between Owl and Mouse similar to the one between Fox and Mouse?

(p. 13) What surprise do you learn about in the stage directions? What do you think will happen now that the Gruffalo has entered? What makes you think so? (pp. 14–19) How are the narrator's lines different from the ones spoken by Mouse or the Gruffalo?

(p. 20) Which character exits the stage? Why does Owl exit?

(pp. 21–25) Why do you think the author chose to tell this story as a play? How does the play format suit this story? How does the play end?

What Insects Do

GENRE: Informational Text • **TEXT TYPE:** Picture Book **THEMES/IDEAS:** identifying things insects do; naming insects

Book Talk

Book Talk begins each lesson.

Show the book cover and help children identify the picture of the caterpillar. Then say: Imagine that you are a nature photographer and your job is to take pictures of interesting insects. As a nature photographer, each day you go to places where you think you will find interesting insects to photograph.

Now pretend you have a camera or cell phone camera and pick it up. Look at the caterpillar on the cover of the book and imagine that it is real. Be careful not to come too close to the caterpillar, but try to get close enough to take the best picture that you can.

Stay very still. Get ready. Focus. Then "Click!" Now you have an amazing picture of a caterpillar. Remind children that a caterpillar is not a full-grown insect. Explain that like all animals, insects grow and change. Ask: What will the caterpillar on the cover be when it grows up and changes?

Let's read the title of the book, What Insects Do. How does the picture on the cover let you know that this story is about real insects, not funny storybook insects?

Browse the Book

Guide children to take a picture walk through the book, spread by spread. Help children identify what each insect does. Then locate and read the label that tells the name of the insect and read it aloud. Ask:

- What would you say this book is about?
- What are some things you think you will learn about insects?

EL SUPPORT Use hand motions while reviewing action words and ask ELs to repeat each action word several times after you.

Print Awareness Hint Remind children that every sentence ends with an end mark. Sometimes that end mark is a period. A period tells the reader to stop.
