

Thanksgiving Games



Cut out the Thanksgiving-themed word cards along the dotted lines and use them to play Pictionary or Charades.

Pictionary



- Use paper and markers or a writing app on your phone or tablet to draw your pictures during the game.
- Divide players into teams.
- Teams take turns having a player select a word card and draw the image while teammates guess the word or phrase.
- Each team scores a point for each word or phrase answered correctly.
- For extra fun, set a time limit.

Variations

- Use colored markers or crayons to add variety and pizzazz to your drawings.
- Add words or phrases that have special meaning or reference to your family, including family member names.

Charades

- Divide players into teams.
- Teams take turns having a player act out a word card while teammates guess the word or phrase.
- Each team scores a point for a word or phrase answered correctly.
- Each performer has one minute to perform for the team while they make guesses.

Variations

- Have two people from the team perform the word or phrase at the same time.
- Try having each performer act out the word or phrase while blindfolded.
