Q: How long did the first Thanksgiving last?

A: It lasted for three days!

Q: Which balloon character has appeared most in the Macy's Thanksgiving Day parade?

A: That's none other than Snoopy, who has floated through the Manhattan sky six times so far!

Q: How many sounds do turkeys make?

Hint: It's not just gobble gobble!

A: Turkeys make more than 25 known sounds, which include "cackle," "hiss," "putt," and "yelp."



Q: What do you think The Pilgrims and Native Americans ate at the first Thanksgiving in 1621?

Q: Do you know when Thanksgiving became a national holiday?

A: In 1863. President Lincoln made the declaration after Sarah Josepha Hale, author of “Mary Had a Little Lamb,” proposed the holiday as a way to unify the country during the Civil War.
