DIY YOUR PARTY! FABRIC RIBBON GARLAND

Use fabric scraps to make a fun decoration for your room or party.


WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Fabric scraps (12 inches or longer)
- Ruler or tape measure
- String
- Sharp scissors



GET STARTED

- 1. Cut string to match the length of the garland you want. To make a garland that could hang over a standard door, measure string to about 36 inches.
- Tie or tape the string between two chairs (or other sturdy objects).

















- 3. Cut or rip the fabric scraps into strips to make fabric ribbons. Make the ribbons about 2 inches wide and 12 inches long. Or they can be a mix of sizes.
- 4. Fold one fabric ribbon in half. Hold the loop behind the string. Take the two ends of the fabric ribbon, fold them up, and pass them through the loop. This will make what's called a lark's head knot around the string.
- 5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 until you have knotted enough fabric ribbons to cover the string.
- 6. Trim the ends of the fabric ribbons.
