

Four-fold Story Board

Scene #

This is a quick and copy-free method of storyboarding for students. Fold a piece of copy paper or graph paper into quarters and label the quarters with the words **See**, **Say**, **Need** and **Do**. In the top right corner, write the scene number to help keep the scenes in order. Use the descriptions below as an example

See Describe the scene location or images that will be on-screen.	Say Write the lines for each character or the voice-over you will record.
<i>This scene will be filmed at the playground swings. We will have a video of someone pushing a friend on the swing.</i>	<i>Person pushing: " A force is a push or a pull." Person on swing: " Force gives an object the energy to move."</i>
Need List the props, extras and equipment needed for this scene.	Do List each team member s responsibilities - who will play each role, who will film, who will manage props.
<i>Playground swings and video camera</i>	<i>Jacob: Camera person Julie: Person pushing John: Person on swing</i>
