

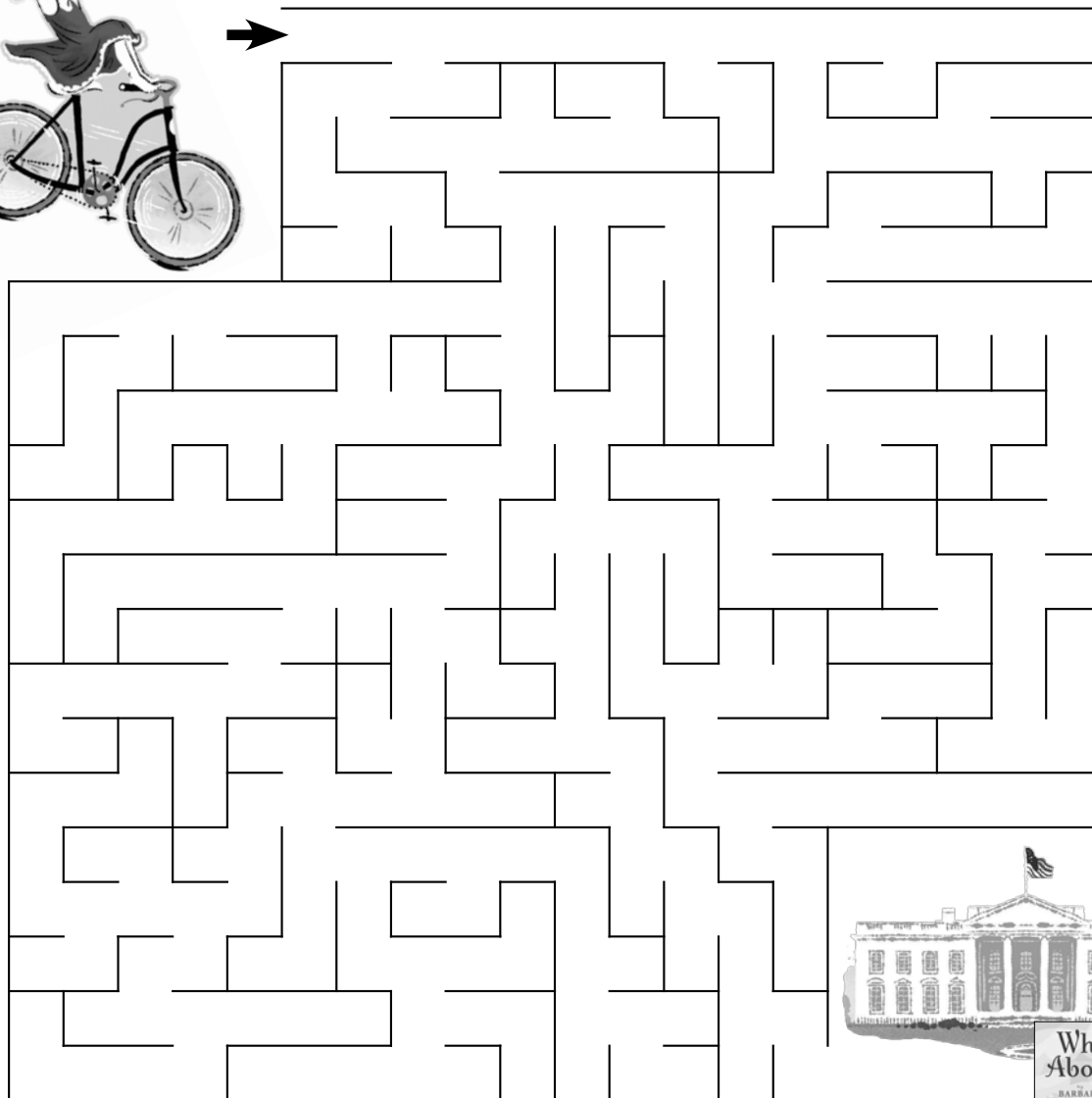


# HELP ALICE FIND HER WAY HOME
