This activity is a YUMMY and FUN way for your kiddos to explore nonstandard measurement! Provide students with a baggie of 15 mini marshmallows and 12 big marshmallows. Students will measure the line and write how many mini marshmallows long it is and how many big marshmallows long it is.

My sweeties worked on this with a partner throughout the week during Math Menu. At the end of the week, we snacked on the extra (and CLEAN!) marshmallows! YUM!
