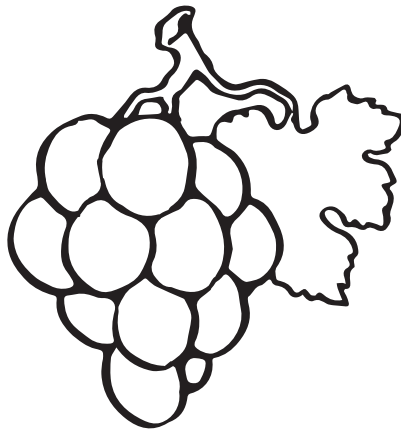


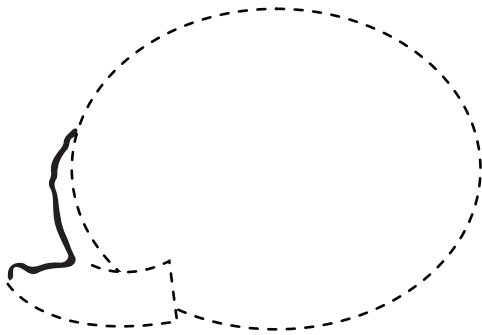
I take these circles,

Quite tall.



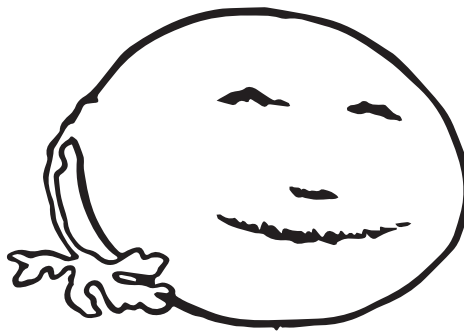
Then with the help

For you and me.



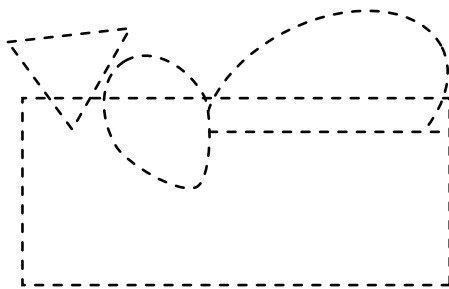
And, since the day

It can't be beat.



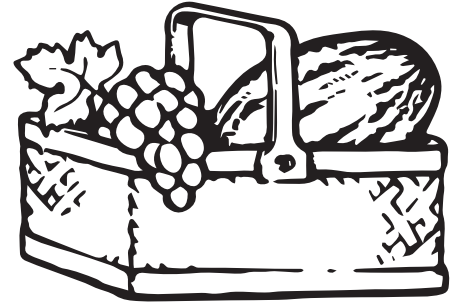
A watermelon

These things 'round.



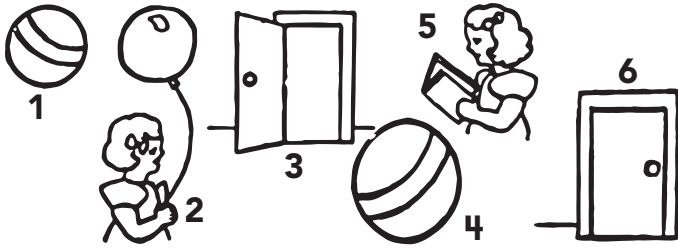
We use an oblong

that run along,



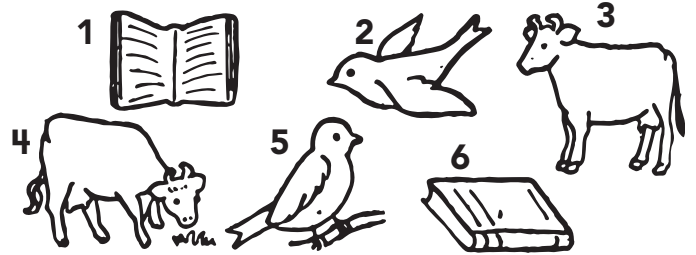
And here we have
