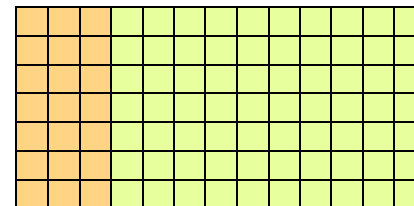
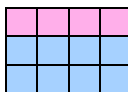
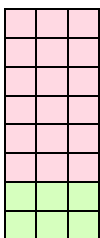
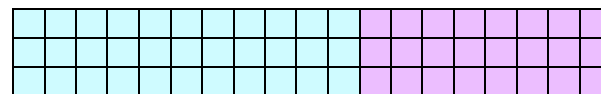
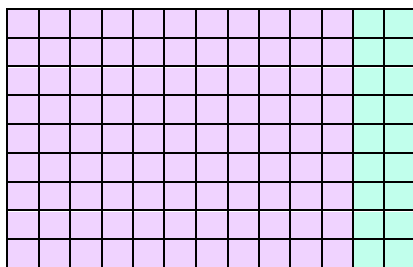
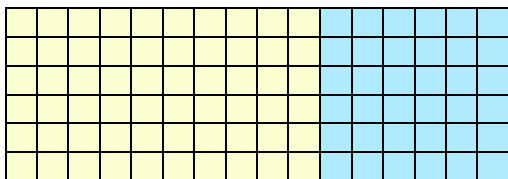
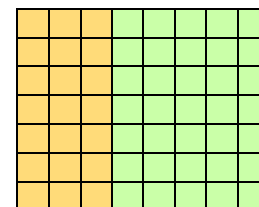
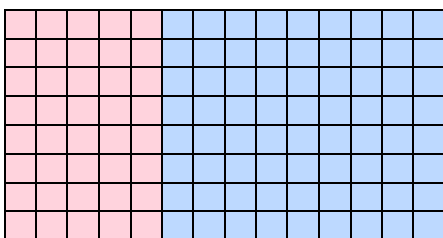
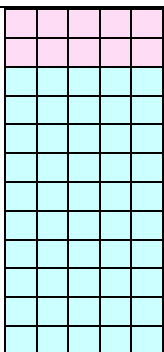
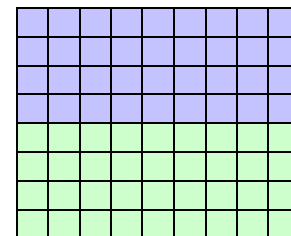
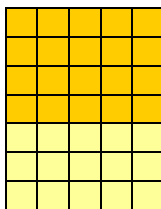
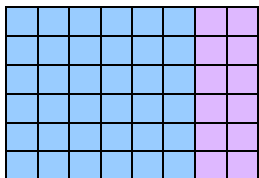
Match the 12 sets of cards (three cards per set) to group the area multiplication model with the two matching expressions.
