Your conclusion should:

- ☑ Remind the reader of the essay's central idea with a fresh rephrasing of the thesis statement
- ☑ Summarize the claims and main points of the essay
- ☑ Answer the "So What?" question (Why are the ideas important? Why should your reader care?)
- ☑ Include a closing sentence with a precept that connects to a big idea of your topic

Remember to leave your readers with a final and lasting impression that makes them glad they read your essay.
