

# Red Hot Vocabulary Study

Red Hot Vocabulary is an opportunity for students to document words that they do not understand. Before reading the book, we discuss the concept.

Students will get a copy of the Vocabulary Template. I share with students that they will be looking for "Words to Know" as we read. It will be the job of the students to document words they have found, the page and context the word has been used in, the definition based on how it is used, and the actual definition.

We then take approximately ten to fifteen words that were commonly listed as a class and create a vocabulary list for the next two weeks. While we are studying and reviewing the terms, we continue reading and finding new words for the coming weeks.

### **Chapters 1-3**
