
HOW TO MAKE PAPER SNOWFLAKES

MATERIALS:


- Paper
- Scissors

DIRECTIONS:


1. Fold paper in half diagonally to make a triangle. If using an 8.5" x 11", you will need to cut off 2" excess paper to make the triangle complete.



2. Fold triangle again to make a smaller triangle. Make sure corners meet.



3. Now, fold triangle one more time. You may need to adjust the creases to get the sides to match up. Crease paper when you get folds just right.



4. Cut out small oval/triangle sections of paper all the way around triangle, this is to create the snowflake effect. Don't worry if the holes are not exactly the same, no two snowflakes are ever alike!
