

## Cause & Effect

**Grade Level: 2-5** 

Subject: Language Arts, Standard 3: Evaluation Strategies

**Duration:** One 40-minute class period

**Activity:** Record causes and effects from *Because of Winn-Dixie* on a graphic organizer.

**Description:** Students discuss the title of the book/movie and how it directly relates to cause and effect. Students find examples from the book/movie of causes and their effects.

**Objectives:** To identify causes and effects. To apply cause and effect to reading of other material, everyday life, history, etc.

Materials: Student worksheet, copy of Because of Winn-Dixie, transparency of graphic organizer

**Procedure:** Begin the lesson with a real-life example of cause and effect. For example, because it is raining today, there will be indoor recess. Solicit other cause/effect relationships from the class. Introduce the graphic organizer as a way to record causes and effects in an easy-to-read format. Write some of the solicited comments in the graphic organizer. Ask the students to briefly discuss in small groups why the title, *Because of Winn-Dixie*, is like cause/effect. Have each group share its findings. Provide a few examples to the class from *Because of Winn-Dixie*.

## Possible examples:

- Because India Opal finds the dog in a grocery store, he is named Winn-Dixie.
- Because of the Civil War, Littmus Block lost most of his family.
- Because of Otis's guitar playing, the animals are mesmerized.

Ask the students to identify other causes and their effects in *Because of Winn-Dixie* on the worksheet.

**Adaptations:** Have students work in small groups or with partners to identify causes and effects. Complete the first graphic organizer as a class. Have the class recite chorally, "Because of Winn-Dixie...," then have students fill in the rest of the sentence with an effect.

**Assessment:** Provide the blank graphic organizer for students to use with examples from real life, history, and even math problems.
