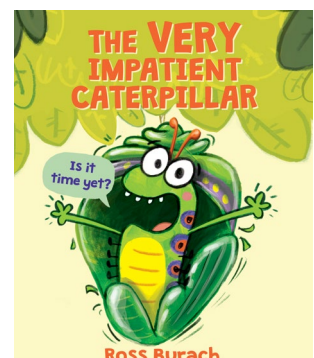

**8. True.**

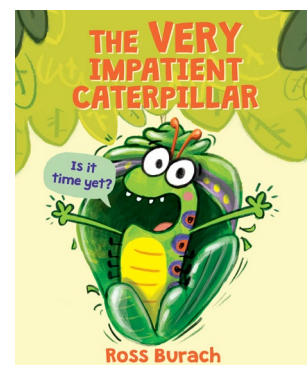
Both male and female butterflies live less than a year, but females outlive males—though sometimes only by days.
