



Off the Map!

You will need:

- 1 large United States Map with grid lines traced with a marker (A silver marker worked well for mine.) and laminated
- 2-4 game pieces (Soft, plastic transportation counters won't slide on slick lamination.
- Direction cards from page 2 of this document laminated and cut apart
- Copies of pages 3-4 (run front to back) for each player

Move one grid square to the east.	Move one grid square to the south.	Move one grid square to the west.
Move one grid square to the north.	Move two grid squares to the east.	Move two grid squares to the south.
Move two grid squares to the west.	Move two grid squares to the north.	Move three grid squares to the east.
Move four grid squares to the east.	Move three grid squares to the south.	Move four grid squares to the south.
Move three grid squares to the west.	Move four grid squares to the west.	Move three grid squares to the north.
Move four grid squares to the north.	Move back to Wichita, Kansas.	Move five grid squares to the west.
Move four grid squares to the east.	Move one box in any direction you choose.	Move two boxes in any direction you choose.

Materials:

- Map
- 2 game pieces

*Place the cards face down next to the map and choose a game piece. Start on the box that contains Wichita, Kansas.

*The first player draws the top card and uses the grid lines on the map to move the number of grid boxes in the direction written on the card. Then, player 1 answers the question for the new destination on the destination sheet while player 2 coaches and checks their answer. Then it is time for player 2 to choose a card.

*Both players move back to Wichita if one player goes off the map unless everyone has finished their destination sheet.
