

# Valentines Box Project

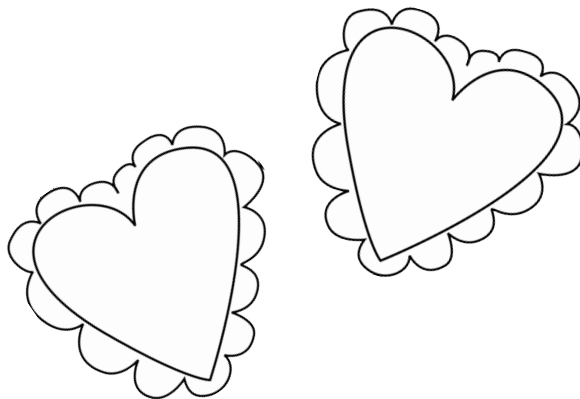

2. Cover and decorate the box.
