


What a Whale!

Use this pattern to make a whale puppet. Just follow the directions on the next page.





What a Whale! (cont.)



What you need:

whale pattern (page 81) • glue • oak tag • crayons • scissors • tape • straw



What you do:

- **1.** Glue the page with the pattern on it to the oak tag.
- 2. Color the whale.
- **3.** Cut out the whale and other parts of the puppet.
- **4.** Tape tab A to the back of the whale's spout, as shown.
- 5. Tape the spout pocket to the back of the whale's body, as shown. The pocket should be just under the small, dark circle at the top of the whale's body near the fin. (This circle is the whale's blowhole.) Tape only the sides of the pocket. Do not tape the top or bottom.
- **6.** Slip the spout into the top of the pocket you just made.
- 7. Pull the tab out from the bottom of the pocket and fold tab A back on the dashed line.
- **8.** Glue a straw to the back of the whale shape. Attach flukes and flipper with brackets or glue. Hold the puppet at the bottom of the straw.
- **9.** To make your whale spout, push the tab up.
