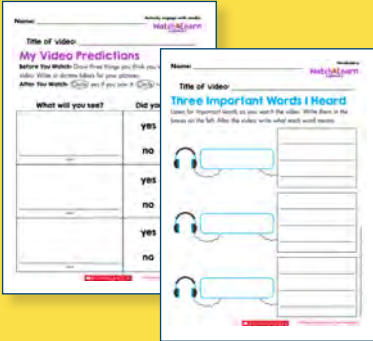

Visuals & Natural Voice

Videos that use natural language and captivating visuals help ELs comprehend vocabulary, content concepts, and instructions immeasurably.

Background Information

Since all students don't have uniform past experiences, providing background knowledge prior to reading or writing activities is particularly essential for ELs.

Review

Fun quizzes allow ELs to hear the information covered in class again to help solidify the day's lesson.

Repetition

Processing and retaining new information takes repetition. Short videos are easy to replay or rewind to reinforce vocabulary and key learning concepts.
