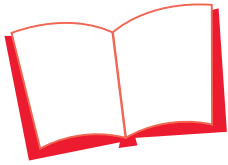

Here are some comprehension questions for young readers to use as they read.

FICTION

### Characters

Describe the characters.

- Traits? Feelings?
- Relationship with others?
- Motivation and goals?

Readers connect to the character's feelings and motivations to better understand the story.

### Problem and Solution

Describe the problem in the story.

- Why is it a problem?
- How does the problem affect the characters?
- What is its impact on the story?

Describe how the problem is solved.

- How does the character solve the problem?
- Does it work right away?

Readers predict how the character will work to solve the problem.

### Lesson Learned

Describe the lesson.

- Think about how the problem is solved. What does the character learn from this?
- Does the character change?
- What can you (the reader) learn?

Characters learn and grow by overcoming their problems. Readers learn and grow by sharing in the character's experiences.

NONFICTION

### Main Idea

What is this text mostly about?

- What is the topic?
- What are you learning about the topic?

How do you know? Find text evidence to support!

Readers identify the main idea by synthesizing text details.

### Author's Point of View

What is the author's point of view on the topic?

How do you know?

Readers use word choice and clues to determine the author's point of view.
