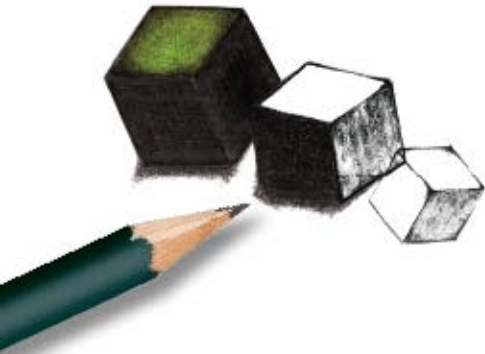


Comic Design: Story and Character Creation
