My Mountain Coaster

Zip down a mountain in the Berkshires on a coaster track you design yourself.

- Cut out the track pieces and arrange them in any order you like on a blank piece of paper.
 Try a few designs, using as many or as few track pieces as you wish. Print out more than one sheet if you need more pieces, or draw your own!
- 2. Secure your coaster course using glue or double-sided tape.
- 3. Add trees, wildflowers, boulders, streams, and other landscape features to your coaster ride. Consider

drawing in some of the wildlife you might find as you coast through the Berkshire Mountains, such as birds, deer, coyotes, fox, beaver, porcupines, snakes, frogs, and butterflies.
