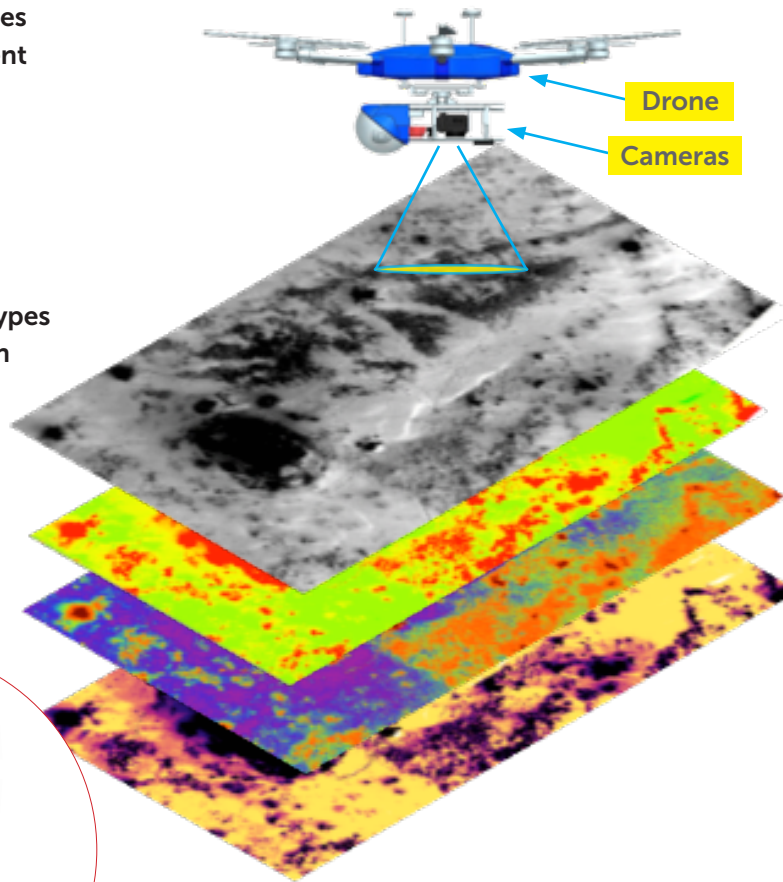


Drone Images, Explained!

Operation PolarEye's **drone** takes pictures that absorb different types of light, kind of like what you'd see through **sunglasses with different colored lenses** (but this camera captures types of light that human eyes can't see!).



Computer software then analyzes how the various kinds of light reflect off the landscape, helping engineers pick out distinct features (snow, plants, etc.). This allows the team to discover important changes in the snow, ice, and Arctic environment.
